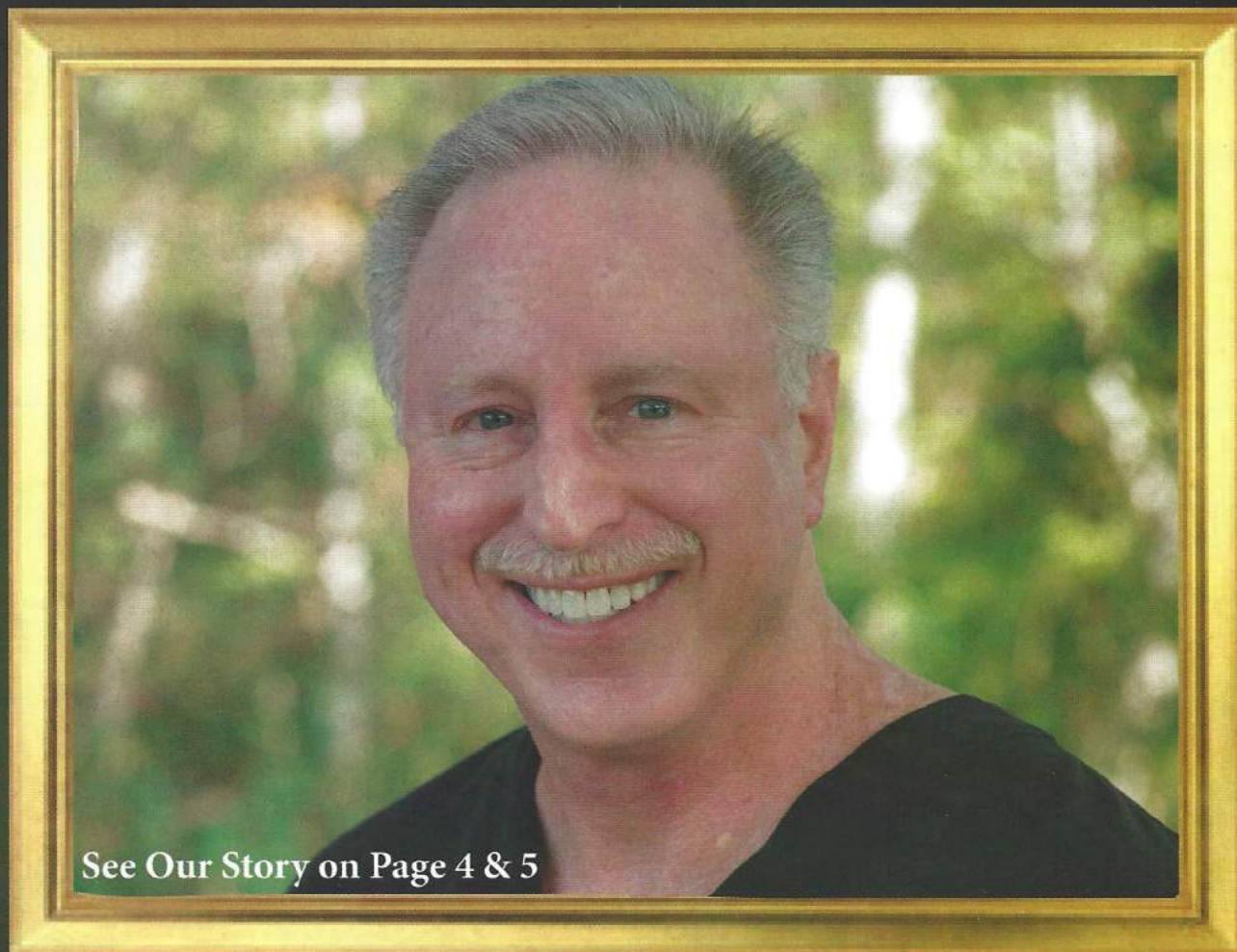

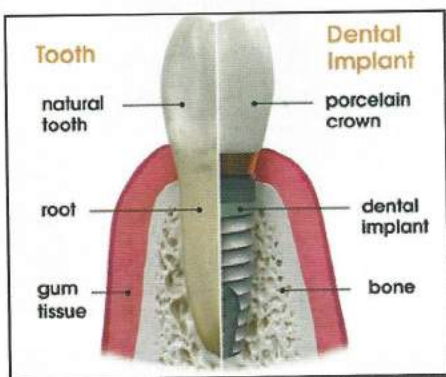

Dental implants look like your natural teeth, and they are anchored in a way that closely replicates your natural tooth root. The actual implant is a small, strong titanium post that replaces the root structure of missing teeth. It becomes part of your jaw, like a natural tooth root, and holds replacement crowns for individual missing teeth, a bridge for a series of missing teeth, or even an over-denture when needed. Implants are durable. They can last the rest of your life. Moreover, you care for them the same as you do your natural teeth – brushing, flossing and twice yearly dental check-ups. They require none of the special care or solutions that become an added part of your life with most other replacement dentures.



Since dental implants are permanently anchored, they give predictable outcomes. For you, this means Dr.

Schwartz can skillfully reshape your face to its natural contours – and literally give you back your smile. Cone Beam CT Scan with 3-D Imaging is one of the tools most recently added to the list of unique services provided within his own office. This modern imaging technique is currently only found in the upper echelon of dental practices. Dr. Schwartz is now able to get a high-resolution 3-D image of a patient's mouth. It exposes the patient to minimal radiation and takes only 17 seconds to complete. Dr. Schwartz can view a patient's jawbone from multiple angles to ensure proper and precise placement of dental implants.



More than 50 years ago, a university researcher in Scandinavia discovered that titanium has properties that living bone willingly accepts. There was none of the long-term



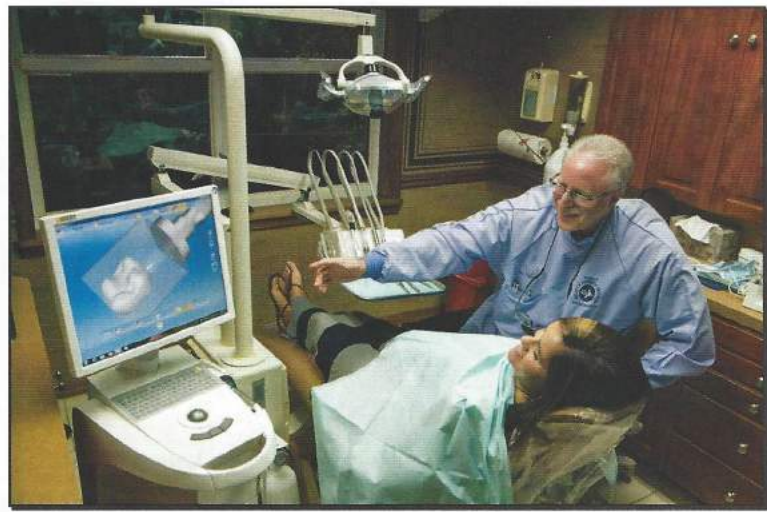
soft tissue inflammation or outright rejection associated with other surgically introduced substances. Under the right conditions, titanium becomes integrated into the structure of living bone. The constant progress and improvements in technique mean that today skilled dentists report approximately a 95 percent success rate with implants. And, recent advancements are continuing to improve even that success rate.

Implants enhance your comfort and appearance when eating. They provide additional stability where your jaw has suffered tooth loss. And, they can give you back your natural self-confidence, end embarrassment, improve speech, improve health and make you look better.

Most adults are good candidates for dental implants. The important first step is to make a dental appointment with Dr. Schwartz for a full evaluation that covers your individual circumstances. ican Academy of Implant Dentistry. He also completed a 2 year, 600 hour comprehensive dentistry course at the University of Florida. Extensively trained and experienced in esthetic dentistry, Dr. Schwartz has been veneering teeth since 1979.
