

Brandon Dentist Receives 2011 Mastership Award from the Academy of General Dentistry

In addition to Mastership in the AGD, Dr. Schwartz has attained the status of Diplomate of the American Board of Oral Implantology/Implant Dentistry (achieved by one tenth of 1% of U.S. dentists), Fellowship in both the American Academy of Implant Dentistry and the International Congress of Oral Implantologists, and Associate Fellow of the World Clinical Laser Institute.
