General dentistry, implants, computer guided implant surgery, Teeth-in-a-Day™, Invisalign®, Zoom!®, KOR and Rembrandt Whitening, Lamineers, veneers and crowns are offered. In addition, periodontal therapy, laser assisted periodontal therapy, laser bacterial reduction, root canal therapy, extractions, dentures, breath care are others among the comprehensive services provided. Dr. Schwartz is also highly skilled in sedation dentistry and even the most apprehensive dental patients feel confident knowing they are receiving the most thorough, personalized treatment from a dentist so uniquely qualified and highly credentialed.

Cone Beam CT Scan with 3-D Imaging is one of the tools most recently added to their list of unique services provided within their own office. This modern imaging technique is currently only found in the upper echelon of dental practices. Dr. Schwartz is now able to get a high-resolution 3-D image of a patient's mouth. It exposes the patient to minimal radiation and takes only 17 seconds to complete. Dr. Schwartz can view a patient's jaw

bone from multiple angles to ensure proper and precise placement of dental implants.

Dr. Schwartz earned a Bachelor's degree from State University of New York at Albany and his Doctor of Dental Surgery degree from New York University College of Dentistry in 1979. He then went on to complete a general practice residency at Albany Medical Center Hospital where he also served as assistant instructor in the Department of Surgery. He then went into private practice; he was an instructor at New York University College of Dentistry and was on staff at Maimonides and Southside Hospitals.

Dr. Schwartz's continued education includes a number of surgical and prosthetic programs on osseointegrated implants, among them a 330 hour maxi course through the Medical College of Georgia and the American Academy of Implant Dentistry. He has also completed 600 hours in the University of Florida Comprehensive Dentistry Advanced Curriculum.

Throughout his career, and through thousands of hours of training and education, extensive testing and case presentations, Dr. Schwartz has accomplished a number of challenging and prestigious designations including: Diplomate, American Board of Oral Implantology/Implant Dentistry; Fellow, American Academy of Implant Dentistry; Fellow and Associate Fellow, American Academy of Implant Dentistry; Master, Academy of General Dentistry and Associate Fellow World Clinical Laser Institute. Additionally, Dr. Schwartz served on the Department of Surgery at Brandon Regional Hospital from 1986 until 2006. Dr. Schwartz is 1 of only approximately 170 active U.S. dentists to have been honored with Diplomate of the American Board of Oral Implantology/Implant Dentistry.

Even with this extensive list of accomplishments and credentials, Dr. Schwartz continues to pursue further mastery through continued education and dedication to the advancement of dentistry. ### The CEREC System

CEREC is an acronym for Chairside Economical Restoration of Esthetic Ceramics. It is a CAD/CAM system, (Computer Aided Design/Computer Aided Manufacturing), that incorporates a camera, computer and milling machine in one instrument. This breakthrough instrument makes it possible for Dr. Schwartz to economically restore damaged teeth in a single appointment using a high





quality ceramic material that matches the natural color of the patient's other teeth.

CEREC is used for partial and full crowns, veneers and other single-tooth restorations. The way CEREC works is, first, Dr. Schwartz prepares the damaged tooth for restoration. The special camera is used to take an accurate picture of the prepared tooth. This digital optical impression is transferred and displayed on a color computer screen, where CAD technology is used to design the restoration chairside. Then CAM takes over and creates the restoration while the patient waits. The tooth is milled out of a block of ceramic material that matches the patient's tooth. The restoration is then stained, glazed and baked in an oven. Finally, Dr. Schwartz bonds the newly milled restoration to the surface of the old tooth using an adhesive.

The entire process takes about two hours of patient chair time. The benefits of this technology to the patient are many. First, a natural-looking restoration means no more silver fillings discoloring smiles. The filling is compatible with tissue in the mouth, anti-abrasive and plaque resistant and strong. No messy impressions are needed and the patient does not have to deal with temporaries. Only one appointment is needed, so there's less time in the dental chair. The three week wait for a laboratory produced restoration is avoided.

CEREC has over 30 years of clinical research and documentation to support the technology. The restorations have been proven precise, safe and effective.

Master Ceramist, Alfredo Losoya oversees all ceramic restorations right in Dr. Schwartz's office. Whether your restoration is a single crown or a complete smile makeover the skilled hands and artistic eyes of a master ceramist will ensure your satisfaction with the final restoration.

## Teeth In A Day™

Dr. Schwartz is one of a select few dentists in the country trained to offer this revolutionary new procedure that is a state-of-the-art alternative to dentures. Through a cutting edge development in the dental industry called "Teeth in A Day," Dr. Schwartz is now able to replace an entire mouthful of teeth or dentures with a permanent set of new teeth in just one appointment. The same technique may be used for the replacement of a single missing tooth as well.



With millions of Americans facing a life without teeth, "Teeth in A Day" can instantly change a patient's life. This new

procedure, in one day, provides patients with a new, natural-looking smile that feels like permanent teeth, works like permanent teeth, is cared for like permanent teeth and may last even longer.

The benefits of "Teeth in A Day" over traditional implant surgery is that this protocol restores a full arch of upper or lower teeth with the placement of just four to six strategically placed implants. In most cases there is minimal bone grafting or sinus grafting. Most importantly, unlike traditional implant surgery, there is no waiting for the new set of teeth. In just one appointment, the surgery is performed and a fixed bridge with a full set of beautiful new teeth is secured on to the implants. While the teeth are permanent, the bridge can be removed for hygienic reasons such as cleanings.



## INVISALIGN®

Invisalign® invisible braces are the clear alternative to metal braces. In fact, virtually no one will know you're wearing them. Right before your eyes, your teeth will move - little by little - toward the smile you have always wanted. Dr. Schwartz is a Preferred Invisalign® doctor and offers a free consultation to evaluate and determine if you're a good candidate for Invisalign which now addresses most cases, from simple to more complex. This free consultation will also be your opportunity to ask any questions you have about the treatment: costs, dental/orthodontic insurance, or any other concerns.

The treatment begins with x-rays, pictures and impressions of your teeth, which will include a digital 3-D image of them. From these records Dr. Schwartz will map out a precise treatment plan, including the exact movements of your teeth. Using the Invisalign technology, he will even be able to show you a virtual representation of how your teeth will move with each stage of treatment. Based on your individual treatment plan, a series of custom-made, clear aligners are then created specifically for you. These aligners are made of a smooth, comfortable BPA-free plastic that won't irritate your cheeks and gums like traditional metal braces often do. Simply wear them throughout the day, and remove them when you eat or to brush and floss your teeth. As you wear each set of aligners, your teeth gently and gradually begin to shift into place.

Approximately every two weeks, you will begin wearing a new set of aligners, advancing you to the next stage of your treatment. To monitor your progress, you will also have occasional checkups with Dr. Schwartz, usually only every six weeks. At every stage, you will be able to see how much closer you are to having the smile that reflects the real you.

While every case is unique to each patient, treatment typically takes approximately 14 months for adults. For teens, the length of treatment is comparable to that of braces. For best results and a timely outcome, you should wear your aligners for 22 hours per day, throughout your entire treatment.
