DIRECTIONS FOR TAKING MEDICATIONS

See checked boxes

- Take Amoxicillin 500 mg, one capsule, 4 times daily. Begin one day prior to your dental appointment.
- Take Clindamycin 150mg, one capsule, 4 times daily. Begin one day prior to your dental appointment.
- Take Clindamycin 300mg, one capsule, 3 times daily. Begin one day prior to your dental appointment.
- Take Amoxicillin 875 mg, one capsule, 2 times daily. Begin one day prior to your dental appointment.
- Take Ibuprofen 800 mg, one tablet, 3 to 4 times daily as needed for pain. Take over the counter Tylenol (acetaminophen), regular or extra strength, according to recommended dosage, every 4-6 hours in addition to Ibuprofen, if needed for additional pain relief.
- Take Oxycodone 5 mg , Norco 5/325mg, **or** Hydrocodone/Acetaminophen 5/325mg one tablet, every 6 hours in addition to Ibuprofen and Tylenol, as needed for pain. Keep in mind that Oxycodone and Norco are narcotics. They will cause drowsiness- **DO NOT DRIVE**. If you are physically active while taking a narcotic, you are likely to become nauseous. If you experience nausea taking a narcotic, we can prescribe for you an antidote for nausea which you may take to avoid nausea.
- Take Xanax 0.5 mg one tablet one hour before bed the night before your dental appointment. Take the second tablet one hour prior to your dental appointment. You cannot drive on this medication.
- Take the Medrol Dose Pack as indicated on the package. Start one day (morning) prior to procedure.
- Bring Triazolam 0.25 mg 2 tablets with you to your appointment. We will have you take these in office so we may monitor you. DO NOT DRIVE while taking this medication.
